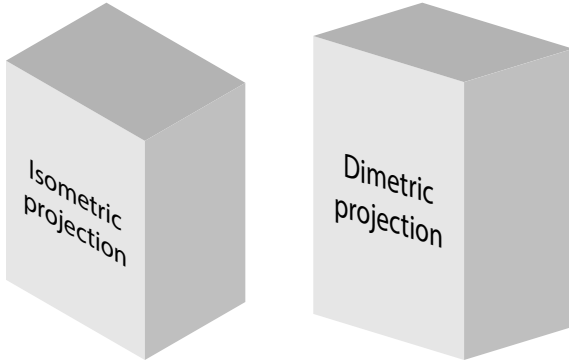


Isometric Projection scripts

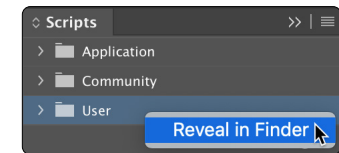
This group of scripts automates the process of converting flat artwork into isometric or dimetric projections.



Installation

Follow the steps below to copy the script to the correct location:

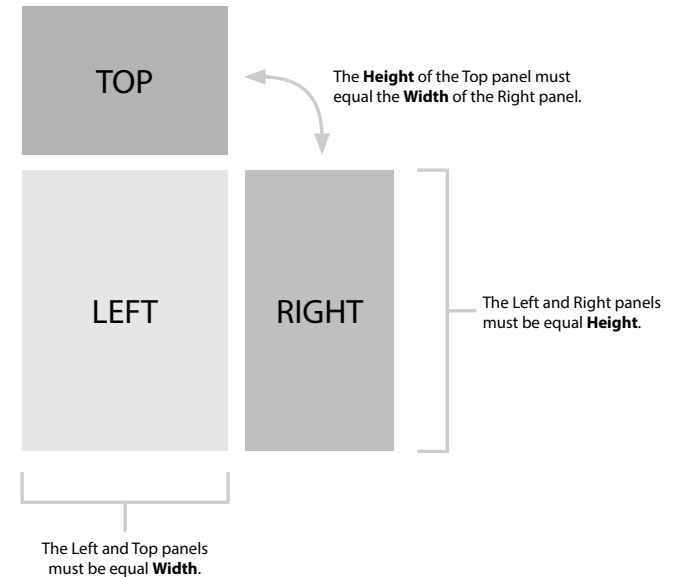
1. Run InDesign.
2. Display the Scripts panel on the screen (*Window > Utilities > Scripts*).
3. Right-click the *User* folder in the panel, and choose *Reveal in Finder* (Mac) or *Reveal in Explorer* (Windows).
4. Copy the *Dimetric Projection* folder and the *Isometric Projection* folder into the folder that is highlighted in the Finder/Explorer.
5. Return to InDesign, and you should see the script appear in the *User* folder in the Scripts panel.

Using the scripts

1. Create flat artwork that represents the top, left, and right sides of the object you want projected.
 - The height of the top must equal the width of the right side
 - The left and right sides must be equal height
 - The left side and top must be equal width
2. Select the artwork for the left side and double-click the *1_Isometric-left* or *1_Dimetric-left* script in InDesign's Scripts panel.
3. Select the artwork for the right side and double-click the *2_Isometric-right* or *2_Dimetric-right* script in InDesign's Scripts panel.
4. Select the artwork for the top and double-click the *3_Isometric-top* or *3_Dimetric-top* script in InDesign's Scripts panel.
5. Select the artwork for the left, top, and right, and double-click the *4_Isometric-arrange* or *4_Dimetric-arrange* script in InDesign's Scripts panel.



Compatibility

These scripts have been tested to work with Macintosh and Windows InDesign 2022 and later. It will most likely work with many older versions but this has not been tested.
